



Front Brake Adjustment

 Raise the front wheel off the ground by placing a support block under the engine. Spin the front wheel by hand and measure the distance the front brake lever ① must be moved before the brake starts to engage.

Free play at the end of the brake lever should be $0.8 \sim 1.2$ in. $(20 \sim 30 \text{ mm})$.

Major adjustments should be made using the adjuster located at the front wheel.
