

Rear Brake Adjustment

Rear brake pedal free play, measured at the tip of the rear brake pedal ①, should be maintained at 0.8-1.2 in. (20-30 mm). Free play is the distance the brake pedal moves before the brake starts to engage.

Adjust the pedal free play by turning the rear brake adjusting nut ②. Turning the adjusting nut in direction ③ will decrease the brake pedal free play and turning the nut in direction ⑤ will increase the free play.
