
STARTING THE ENGINE

WARNING

- * Never run the engine in a closed area. The exhaust contains poisonous carbon monoxide gas that may cause loss of consciousness and lead to death.
- * Do not try to start the engine with the transmission in gear. You may injure yourself or damage the vehicle.
- * Be sure to release the steering lock before attempting to start the engine.




(1) Vent lever

Preparation

- 1. Select a level surface and lock the parking brake (page 14) before starting the engine.
- 2. Turn the fuel cap vent lever (1) and fuel valve (2) to ON.
- 3. Make sure the engine stop switch (3) is at RUN.
- 4. Make sure that the transmission is in neutral by depressing the gearshift pedal and checking that the neutral indicator is at N and that the neutral indicator lamp lights.
