STARTING THE ENGINE

Your FOURTRAX is equipped with a gear position starter cut-off system. The engine cannot be started if the transmission is in a forward gear—unless the clutch lever is pulled in. The engine cannot be started if the transmission is in reverse gear.

Preparation

- 1. Select a level surface and lock the parking brake (page 22) before starting the engine.
- 2. Turn the fuel valve (1) and ignition switch (2) to ON.
- 3. Make sure the engine stop switch (3) is at run.
- 4. Make sure that the transmission is in neutral by checking that the neutral indicator lamp lights.


