SPARK ARRESTER

The exhaust system must be periodically purged of accumulated carbon.

To purge the system:

- Select a well-ventilated area free of combustible materials and make sure the exhaust pipe is cool.
- 2. Remove the bolts (1) (Fig. 4-34), gasket (2) and spark arrester lid (3).
- 3. Start the engine and rev it up approximately twenty times while momentarily creating exhaust system back pressure by blocking the end of the muffler with a shop towel.
- 4. Stop the engine and allow the exhaust pipe to cool.
- 5. Reinstall the removed parts and tighten the bolts securely.

NOTE:

The two spark arrester screws (4) must be installed in the spark arrester body at all times for the spark arrester to be effective.


