## Caring for Your Motorcycle

- To remove stubborn stains, use diluted detergent and rinse thoroughly with plenty of water.
- Avoid getting gasoline, brake fluid, or detergents on the instruments, windscreen, panels, or headlight.

## **Exhaust Pipe and Muffler**

The exhaust is made of stainless steel, which can become tarnished with burn marks if splattered with oil or other substances when hot. To remove burn marks, use a mild abrasive compound. To remove dirt and mud, use a kitchen cleaning solution for stainless steel and wash with a soft sponge. Rinse with plenty of water to remove all residue When the exhaust pipe and muffler are painted, do not use a commercially available abrasive kitchen cleaning compound. Use a neutral detergent to clean the painted surface on the exhaust pipe and muffler. If you are not sure if your exhaust pipe and muffler are painted, contact your dealer.

## NOTICE

Even though the exhaust is made of stainless steel, it can become stained. Remove all marks and blemishes as soon as they are noticed.
