| 1 | Neutral indicator | Lights when the transmission is in <br> neutral. Lamp Check. |

| 2 | Reverse indicator | Lights when the transmission is in <br> reverse. Lamp Check. |
| 3 | PGM-FI indicator | Lights when there is any <br> abnormality in the PGM-FI <br> (Programmed Fuel Injection) <br> system. Should also light for a few <br> seconds and then go off when the <br> ignition switch is turned on. If the <br> indicator comes on at any other <br> time, reduce speed and take your <br> vehicle to your dealer as soon as <br> possible. Lamp Check. |
| 4 | High coolant <br> temperature <br> indicator | Lights when coolant temperature is <br> high enough to adversely affect the <br> service life of the engine. <br> If the high coolant temperature <br> indicator comes on while you are <br> riding, immediately bring the <br> vehicle to a stop, turn the engine <br> off and let it cool. See page 220. <br> Lamp Check. |
| 5 | PS (Electric Power <br> Steering) indicator | Lights when there is an abnormality <br> in the PS (Electric Power Steering) <br> system. See page 48. Lamp Check. |
