3. Ineffective braking	1. Inoperative front brake cable 2. Loose brake rod 3. Improper brake shoe contact 4. Dirt or water inside the brake	1. Remove foreign object from cable and inspect for bends 2. Inspect and repair 3. Inspect and repair 4. Inspect and repair

6.9 DRIVE CHAIN

Troubles	Probable causes	Corrective action
1. Drive chain stretches frequently	1. Excessive load applied to chain (during riding or gear change) 2. Due to oil leak, excessive lubrication periodically	1. Correct riding technique 2. Perform proper lubrication
2. Excessively worn sprocket	1. Driving with worn sprocket 2. Sprocket mal fitted to drive chain	1. Clean sprocket area 2. Replace with proper sprocket
